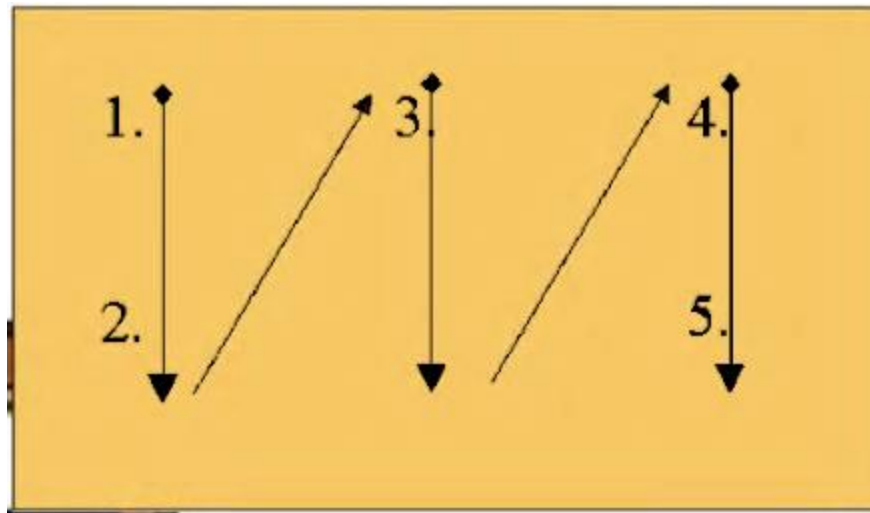

The page size of this poster template is A0 (1661 mm x 1189 mm) with a 25 mm border. Do not change the page size. You can scale back a smaller or larger size when printing. You need a 25 mm border to accommodate a poster stand and a 50 mm poster template.
Bar in this poster does not include up to the white space of the poster. Do not change the size of the bar. Do not make your poster bigger than necessary for the template.
Check with your organization on their specifications of size and orientation before you start your poster. If maximum poster size is not specified, forward a size of 100 cm x 150 cm.
The page size of this poster template is A0 (1661 mm x 1189 mm) with a 25 mm border. Do not change the page size. You can scale back a smaller or larger size when printing. You need a 25 mm border to accommodate a poster stand and a 50 mm poster template.

Tips for making a successful poster
• Rewrite your poster in a smaller format. Simply everything, stick rules overkill.
• Headings and section headings should be bold and clear, easy to read.
• Leave 20 mm between rows of text and 10 mm between lines of text.
• When using colour, your poster should be printed on a high quality paper.
• Try using photographs or diagrams graphs, avoiding numerical tables.
• Spell check and grammar check before printing.

Printing/proofing files
Images such as photographs, graphs, diagrams, logos, etc. can be added to the poster.
To have a colour image on your poster, go through the following steps to save it from the file to the folder on your computer, select it and press OK.
The computer image files are saved as JPEG or TIFF, if possible, respectively.
Beware of the image size you are printing. The average dot per inch (DPI) of 300 DPI would be suitable for a 100 mm x 150 mm poster. Do not use high resolution for the web.
Files as photographs
For photographs use MS Word or a photograph directly in Power Point.
Graphics should be created in the programs (e.g. Sigma Plot, Origin, SPSS, etc.) and should be saved as JPEG or TIFF if possible. For more information see MU.

Printing and laminating
Once you have completed your poster, bring it down to MU for printing. We will provide a table with printing charges and a list of rules. The final poster will then be printed and laminated.
Note: Do not take your poster until the laminator has finished working and both machines are cool.
